

FORD COUNTY SPECIAL BOARD MINUTES
November 21, 2013

A. CALL TO ORDER:

The County Board of Ford County met pursuant to adjournment in the Ford County Board room of the Ford County Jail in Paxton on Thursday, November 21, 2013, at 3:00 P.M. The meeting was called to order by County Board Chairman, Rick Bowen.

B. ROLL CALL:

Attorney Mool said that she will need an appraisal of the real estate and personal property.
